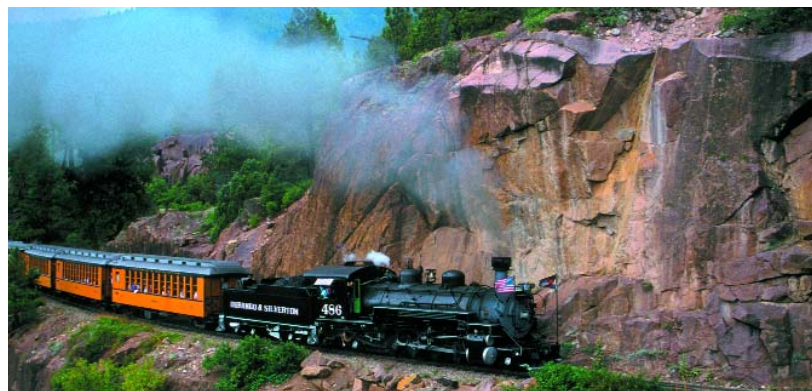


# North America
