## 6 Days – Great Trains & Grand Canyons

### Day 1: Phoenix – Sedona

Day of leisure. Farewell Dinner at the Blazin' M Ranch for a Chuckwagon Supper & Western Stage Show.

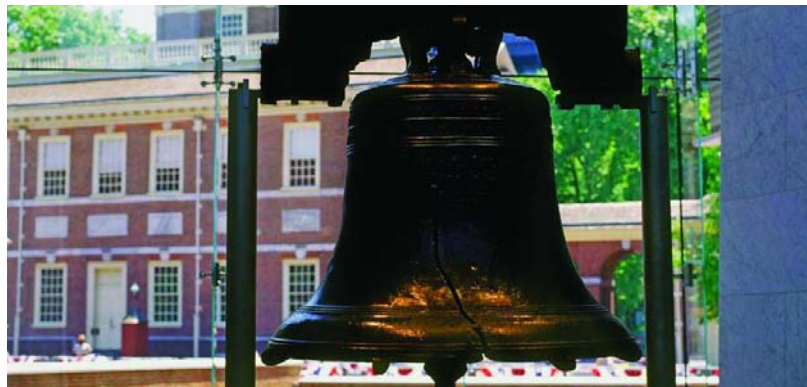
### Day 6: Sedona – Scottsdale – Flight Home
