6 Days – Oregon Trails

Day 1: Flight to Portland

Fly to Portland, Oregon, “City of Roses” for a five night stay. Portland features a collection of gardens, world class museums, historic districts along with acres of parks typical of the Pacific Northwest. Welcome Dinner.

Day 2: Astoria – Oregon Coast – Winery Visit

Arrive in Astoria situated where the Columbia River meets the Pacific Ocean. Visit Fort Clatsop National Memorial, commemorating the 1805-06 winter encampment of the Lewis & Clark Expedition. Travel to Rockaway & Cannon State Beaches. Tour the Tillamook Cheese Factory. This afternoon, enjoy a Winery Visit & Tasting to sample a few of the varieties produced in this region.

Day 3: Portland Sightseeing – Mt. St. Helens

Visit Mt. St. Helens Volcanic National Park. Visit the Johnston Ridge Observatory.

Day 5: Multnomah Falls – Columbia Gorge Cruise

See Multnomah Falls, the second highest year-round waterfall in the nation. Cruise aboard the Sternwheeler Columbia Gorge, an authentic paddle wheeler providing breathtaking vistas. Also see the Bonneville Dam. Farewell Dinner.
