7 Days – Red Cliffs Adventure **New!**

Day 1: Arrive Salt Lake City – Welcome Dinner

Day 2: Salt Lake City – Moab

Salt Lake City Tour: State Capitol and Temple Square. Travel to scenic Moab filled with red cliffs & painted canyons. Arrive at the Red Cliffs Lodge for a 4-night stay. Nestled high on the banks of the Colorado River, the lodge is surrounded by magnificent Red Rock Cliffs.

Day 3: Canyonlands National Park

Day 1: Flight to Nashville
