Day 1: Overnight Flight

Day 2: Arrive Zagreb, Croatia – Welcome Dinner

Day 3: Zagreb – Zadar

Zagreb City Tour: Upper Old Town, St. Stephen's Cathedral, St. Marks Church, Jelacic Square & Mirogoj Park Cemetery. Travel to Zadar for two nights.
