Swiss Highlights Itinerary

Day 1: Overnight Flight

Depart on your overnight flight to Europe to begin your **Swiss Highlights Tour**.

Day 2: Arrive in Switzerland

Upon arrival in **Switzerland** meet your Premier World Discovery Tour Director. Later arrive in **Montreux** located on the shores of **Lake Geneva** to begin a six night stay at the elegant and famous **Fairmont Montreux Palace**. Tonight join your Tour Director and fellow travelers for a **Welcome Dinner**.

Meal - (D) Overnight - Montreux

Day 3: Geneva - Castle of Chillon - Wine Tasting

This morning enjoy a **Geneva City Tour** to see the **Jet d'Eau** (400 ft. high waterspout), the famous **Flower Clock** and the **United Nations Building**. Enjoy some time at your own pace in Geneva for lunch, shopping and/or a cafe experience. Later tour of the 12th century **Chateau de Chillon**, a fascinating castle on Lake Geneva made famous by Byron's epic poem, "The Prisoner of Chillon." Later drive along the "Corniche" - a steep and narrow road through vineyard villages to experience a **Swiss Wine Tasting**. In these villages, the "Lavaux" wine growers live and press their own grapes. Visit a local wine cellar to sample & taste the wines of the region. This evening dinner is included at a popular local restaurant.

Meals - (B,D) Overnight - Montreux

Day 4: Zermatt

Depart Montreux and travel through the impressive **Rhone Valley** highlighting orchards and vineyards. Arrive in Tasch to board a **Cogwheel Railway** for the short trip to the famous car-free Alpine resort of **Zermatt**. Zermatt is situated at the foot of the majestic **Matterhorn**, one of the world's most famous mountain peaks. Enjoy free time to explore Zermatt on your own. Maybe on your own ride up to the **Gornergrat** (weather permitting--10,130 ft above sea level) offering incredible views of the Matterhorn and 29 of the highest peaks in Europe.

Meal - (B) Overnight - Montreux

Day 5: Bern - Interlaken

Today visit **Bern**, the beautiful capital city of Switzerland featuring cobblestone streets under medieval arches making it one of Europe's most picturesque cities & registered as a UNESCO historic site. Enjoy a **Bern City Tour** to see the famous **Bear Pits**, the **House of Parliament**, the **Rose Garden** and the impressive **Cathedral**. Enjoy time at leisure in Bern's Old Town dining, exploring, strolling and/or shop-

ping. This afternoon stop in **Interlaken**, a charming town situated between Brienz & Thun Lakes and surrounded by incredible mountain scenery. Return to Montreux for an evening at leisure.

Meal - (B) Overnight - Montreux

Day 6: Golden Pass Train to Gstaad & Gruyeres

This morning board the **Golden Pass Train** and travel from Montreux to Gstaad. Sit back, relax and enjoy the panoramic mountain scenery enroute to the small resort village of **Gstaad**. Later board a motor-coach and travel to **Gruyeres**, a charming hilltop town famous for a 12th century castle. Gruyeres is an unspoiled, car-free medieval village with lovely houses along cobblestone streets. Next visit a **Swiss Cheese Dairy** where you can see cheese being made and taste the finished product.

Meal - (B) Overnight - Montreux

Day 7: Leisure Day/Two Country Tour

The entire day is free to relax or explore more of Montreux on your own. An optional Two Country excursion will be available to France & Italy. The excursion begins with a visit to the ski resort of Chamonix, home of the first Winter Olympics in 1924 and situated at the foot of Mont-Blanc, the highest peak in Europe. Later travel via the Mont Blanc Tunnel into Italy & pass through typical Italian villages with spectacular views of the Alps. Visit the medieval town of Aosta, the first town south of the Alps. Then travel via the Great St. Bernard Tunnel and return to Montreux. Tonight enjoy a **Farewell Dinner** at a special local restaurant with your Tour Director and fellow travelers.

CANCELLATION WAIVER & POST DEPARTURE PLAN

- Cancel 74-45 days prior to departure: 25% of total price
- Cancel 44-15 days prior to departure: 50% of total price
- Cancel 14 days or less prior to departure/no shows: No refunds
