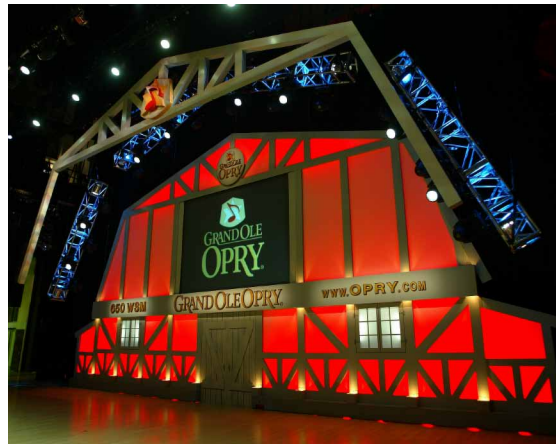

Branson, Memphis & Nashville Itinerary

Day 1: Flight - St. Louis, MO

Arrive in **St. Louis**, meet your Tour Director and transfer to your hotel. St. Louis was once the major gateway for westward pioneers and is now home to a revitalized waterfront and wonderful museums.

Overnight - St. Louis

Day 2: St. Louis - Branson

This morning enjoy a panoramic **St. Louis City Tour** to see the famous **Gateway Arch** and **Union Station**, the former train station converted to a shopping complex. Then travel to **Branson**, considered "The Live Music Show Capital of the World!" Enjoy three nights in Branson taking in several shows and attractions. Tonight experience one of the top music and dance shows in Branson, the **Duttons Show**. The Dutton Family performers play everything from bluegrass to classical and feature a variety of instruments.

Day 3: Branson

Today visit **Silver Dollar City**, the popular turn-of-the-century theme park highlights the cultural heritage of the Ozarks. Enjoy music, comedy shows, and artisans demonstrating traditional skills such as woodcarving and blacksmithing. This evening board the largest lake cruise vessel in America, the **Showboat Branson Belle**, to enjoy dinner and a music show while cruising picturesque **Table Rock Lake**.

Day 4: Branson

Today venture out on a **Branson City Tour** featuring the College of the Ozarks and the enhanced downtown waterfront, **Branson Landing**. Learn the history of Branson from small mountain town to show capital. Later visit the **Stone Hill Winery** for a tasting and shopping experience. Tonight will be a highlight as you enjoy Branson's most popular performer, **Shoji Tabuchi**. The world class entertainer and violinist will wow you with an amazing performance.

Day 5: Branson - Little Rock - Memphis

This morning travel to **Little Rock**, the capital of Arkansas. Visit the **Clinton Presidential Library & Museum** featuring replicas of the Oval Office and the Cabinet Room, photograph and video exhibits and a time line presenting the work of the President. Later arrive in **Memphis**, Tennessee for a 2-night stay. Located on the banks of the mighty Mississippi River, Memphis is a music capital known as the birthplace of Blues, Rock n Roll and Soul.

Meal - (B) Overnight - Memphis

Day 6: Memphis

This morning enjoy a tour of Elvis Presley's famous **Graceland**, a 14-acre estate, museum and entertainment complex. See Elvis' original business office, trophy building and meditation gardens where the 'King' is laid to rest. Later enjoy a **Memphis City Tour** to learn more about this great southern

city. Travel along the Mississippi River, see Victorian homes and cultural landmarks like the Pyramid Arena. This afternoon visit the **National Civil Rights Museum**, an experience that covers centuries of history. The visit begins at the original Lorraine Motel, the site where Martin Luther King, Jr. was assassinated. Later stop at the historic Peabody Hotel to see the famous **Peabody Duck March** through the lobby. Tonight visit action-packed **Beale Street**, filled with restaurants, shops and blues clubs including BB King's Blues Cafe. Enjoy dinner at a popular local restaurant on Beale Street.

Day 7: Memphis - Nashville

Today travel through central Tennessee to **Nashville**. Rolling terrain, magnificent mansions and historic sights decorate the countryside as your route brings you to **Music City USA**. Arrive at the amazing and renovated **Gaylord Opryland Resort** to begin a two-night stay. The resort complex features three interior gardens under glass roofs including waterfalls, a river and lake system with passenger-carrying flatboats plus a variety of restaurants, lounges and shops. This evening enjoy a performance of the famous **Grand Ole Opry Show**, a Nashville highlight.

Day 8: Nashville

Enjoy a **Nashville City Tour** to see the Parthenon (replica), Old Ryman Auditorium, the State Capitol and famous Music Row. Later visit the **Country Music Hall of Fame** to see how country music has evolved through the past 70 years. The Hall of Fame features memorabilia and displays in a museum setting. Tonight's **Farewell Dinner** is at the famous **Nashville Nightlife Diner Theatre**.

CANCELLATION WAIVER & POST DEPARTURE PLAN

The waiver fee is fully refundable until 180 days prior to departure. **The waiver fee does not cover any single supplement charges which arise from an individual's traveling companion electing to cancel for any reason prior to departure.** The waiver is non-transferable and valid for each applicant only. - Cancel 74-45 days prior to departure: 25% of total price
- Cancel 44-15 days prior to departure: 50% of total price
- Cancel 14 days or less prior to departure/no shows: No refunds
