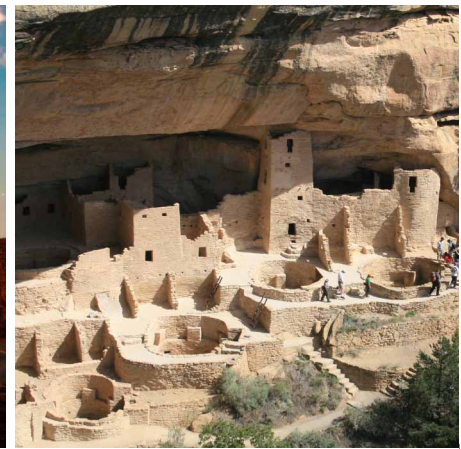

## Southwest Trains & Canyons Itinerary

### Day 1: Arrive Salt Lake City

Today arrive in **Salt Lake City**, "The City of Saints" founded by Brigham Young in 1847. Enjoy a **Welcome Dinner** and get acquainted with your traveling companions.

*Meal: (D) Overnight: Salt Lake City*

### Day 2: Salt Lake City – Moab

This morning enjoy a panoramic **Salt Lake City Tour** featuring the **State Capitol** and **Temple Square** with its lovely landscaping and famous Tabernacle. Later head south to **Moab**, site of many western movies and known as a stop for Butch Cassidy & other outlaws. Tonight enjoy dinner at a local restaurant in Moab.

### Day 3: Arches & Canyonlands National Parks

Today tour two of our country's great national parks. This morning visit **Arches National Park** to see some of the famous arches (over 2,000 in total) and marvel at other red rock formations and canyons. Later visit **Canyonlands National Park** featuring deeply eroded canyons interspersed with sheer-sided mesas and a variety of spires, arches and unusual rock formations. Also stop at **Dead Horse Point State Park** for an amazing view of the Colorado River. Enjoy the evening in Moab at your own pace.

### Day 4: Moab - Mesa Verde National Park - Durango

This morning travel south into Colorado to visit one of our nation's major archeological preserves, **Mesa Verde National Park**. Mesa Verde, Spanish for green table offers a look into the lives of a Native American culture that lived here from AD 600-1300 and later vanished. See some of the 600 cliff dwellings protected in the park including the famous **Cliff Palace**. Then travel to **Durango, Colorado** your home for the next two nights where vestiges of the past accent a Victorian downtown filled with wooden sidewalks, shops & restaurants. Enjoy dinner in Durango on your own.

### Day 5: Durango Silverton Railroad

Today step back into the 1800's to board the **Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad**, the last of its kind in the US. The spectacular train ride takes you through mountains and along sheer cliff walls of the Animas River on a line that has been in continuous use since 1882. The half-day journey ends in **Silverton**, a national historical district.

Return by coach this afternoon to Durango. Tonight enjoy a fun filled dinner during an authentic **Cowboy Dinner & Stage Show**.

### Day 6: Durango - Chama - Santa Fe

Depart early this morning and travel to Chama to board the **Cumbres Toltec & Scenic Railroad**. The full day sightseeing train journey takes you over mountain passes and by gorges as you travel from Chama to Osier for an included lunch stop before continuing to Antonito. Then reboard your motorcoach for the ride to **Santa Fe, New Mexico** for a two night stay in the resort and artist community with Spanish-Pueblo roots.

### Day 7: Santa Fe

This morning enjoy a **Santa Fe City Tour** including details about the history, culture and unique architecture of this artist's mecca. See the **Plaza, Palace of the Governors**, a Santa Fe landmark built in 1610, **Loretto Chapel** and **State Capitol**. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at your own pace in historic Santa Fe. During your Santa Fe leisure time maybe visit one of the many museums, stop by a few art galleries, explore the shops or relax at your hotel. Tonight enjoy a **Farewell Dinner** with your traveling companions.

### CANCELLATION WAIVER & POST DEPARTURE PLAN

- Cancel 74-45 days prior to departure: 25% of total price
- Cancel 44-15 days prior to departure: 50% of total price
- Cancel 14 days or less prior to departure/no shows: No refunds
